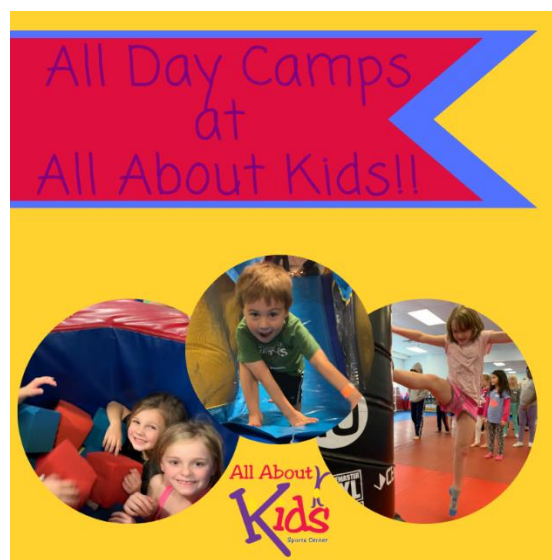
NEW for 2020! We look forward to helping your child navigate NTI while also exploring everything All About Kids has to offer – Open Gym, swimming, organized games and activities and more!

Age Groups

Day Camp is offered for ages 4 and 5. Camp with NTI support is available for Grades 1-5. Children will be split by grade level.

Special notes for 4-5-year olds:

We provide a rest/quiet period so that your camper can recharge for afternoon classes and activities. Please feel free to pack your camper with their favorite book to read at this time! Although numerous restroom breaks are offered, we strongly encourage that your child bring a complete change of clothing. Young campers must be fully potty trained and be able to change in and out of wet/dry clothing without assistance. Please be sure to pack a swim suit and towel for Wednesdays!



What to Bring

All campers will need to arrive in play clothes and a mask and bring a bag including their lunch and snack. You should also pack them with their own water bottle. We are encouraging that each camper brings their favorite book each day. We will have time for reading in the schedule for every group. Don't forget to pack a swim suit and towel on the days that they may need it! Please be sure to label all of your child's belongings with their

first and last name. Please remember to feed your camper breakfast so that they have lots of energy for all the activities planned for that day! Pre-school campers are encouraged to bring a blanket, pillow, or lovey from home for rest time. We play outside each day the weather permits, so please have your child dressed in appropriate footwear and jackets if needed.

NTI Support Campers: Please bring the following each day:

- Device (tablet, laptop, etc.) for school work with charger and headphones
- All necessary supplies for assignments (crayons, paper, scissors, etc.)
- Lunch
- Snack
- Swim attire
- Mask
- Weekly Assignment Form – This is essential in making sure we have all of the information needed to assist your child!

If you need to contact your child throughout the day, please call our office 502-809-1386. If your child needs to contact you, we will call any of the numbers on file. Please ensure that these are up to date in our system.



General Camp Information

Camp Hours

Camp hours are 8:00am-3:00pm. We offer late pick-up to meet your scheduling needs. Late pick-up allows for pick up between 3:00pm and 5:00pm. There is a charge of \$14 per child per day for late pick-up. Campers are not allowed in the building prior to 8:00am. Any camper not picked up by 5:00pm will be charged \$1 per minute after 5:00pm.

PIN Numbers

When you drop off your child, you will be prompted to verify the 4-digit PIN number you gave at registration. You will use this PIN number to pick up your child. If a parent comes to pick up their child without a PIN number, they must provide a valid photo ID and give the phone number on file in order to pick up their child. If someone who is not on the child's account comes to pick up the child, he/she must have the valid PIN number. If not, we will call the parents to verify that they sent this person to pick up the child.

Medications/Allergies

If your child requires medication throughout the day, please bring in a completed medication form that can be printed from our website on your child's first day of camp. Any medications must be labeled with your child's first and last name. Medications will be locked in the med box in the office and administered by a camp counselor or office staff. If your child has allergies, you must let a camp counselor know upon check-in. In this case, your child will be given a neon colored nametag labeled with any food allergies we should be aware of.

No Nit Policy

If a case of head lice is found at camp, the entire group will be checked and a letter will be sent home to all the groups' parents. If a camper is found to have head lice here at camp, the parent will be called and the child will need to be picked up. Regarding re-admittance to camp, the camper must have all lice, lice eggs, and egg cases removed from their head, following the application of pediculicide agent or other treatment as recommended by a pediatrician.

Coronavirus Precautions

In order to keep all of our customers healthy we are taking many precautions to protect our campers. All of our staff and campers are required to wear masks while in the building. Our campers will be required to wear masks during all indoor activities as well. The campers will not need their masks while eating, swimming, or participating in outdoor activities.

For check-in times, if your child is being walked into the facility, they may be accompanied by only one guardian. Both the guardian and camper will have their temperature checked. All campers wash their hands upon arrival and use hand sanitizer throughout the day. During carpool, your camper's temperature will be checked before entering the building and before their parent leaves. During late pick up, the guardian will not enter the building and will wait at the party room door.

We must also follow the CDC guidelines to keep children 6ft apart at all times possible and limit the contact with shared toys and persons in the facility. It is highly suggested that you pack your camper with their favorite book, board game, puzzle, doll/action figure, etc. Please make sure that all of these items are labeled with your camper's name.

If a child is suspected to be ill, they will wait in the front office until they can be picked up. We will call the number that is on file (please make sure that it is updated) and you will need to pick up your child as soon as possible.



Arrival & Departure Procedures

Drop Off

Campers should be dropped off in carpool between 8:00am and 8:15am. One of our friendly staff will welcome you there to check your camper in! Be prepared with their PIN number and any medication information the staff may need to know.



Campers will put all of their belongings in a cubby. Please make sure that everything is labeled with their name. Because these cubbies are not monitored closely for the entirety of camp, we recommend that you do not send your camper with anything of important sentimental value. All About Kids is not responsible for any items that are lost, misplaced, or mixed up with another camper's belongings.

For campers that are dropped off after 8:15am, you will need to stop by the front desk to check your camper in. Please also be prepared with their PIN number and any pertinent medication information. The friendly desk staff will then either escort your camper to their group or have one of their camp counselors come to get them.

If campers are getting dropped off after their lunch period has already happened, please ensure that you feed your camper before they come! We will not designate a separate time for just your camper to eat lunch.

Pick Up

Campers must be picked up by 3:00pm unless they are enrolled in late pick up. If your camper is not picked up by 3:00pm, you will be charged the \$14.00/day late pick up fee.

At 3:00pm all campers will be waiting outside for carpool (if weather permits). The carpool line is required for pick up. If you are picking up before 3:00pm, please park in the drop off zone right in front of the front doors and give our office a call. The front desk will have your camper escorted to you! At any pick up times, be prepared to verify your camper's PIN!

For our late pick up campers, please come into the building to pick them up and check them out at the front desk. For any campers that are enrolled in late pick up and have not been picked up by 5:00pm, parents will be charged \$1.00/minute. If you are going to be late for any reason, we appreciate a call in advance to the office letting us know!

Carpool Instructions

Since we are requiring all campers use the carpool line, we want to keep the wait time as short as possible. Please ensure that your camper is ready to go once you get to the front of the line! Once our friendly staff help your camper out of your vehicle, they will have their temperature checked and walked inside to wash their hands and head to their group!





Cost and Registration

6 Week Program

This is a six week program that runs August 24 – October 2. The first week's tuition is billed upon registration. Each remaining week's tuition will be automatically billed to the card on file the Friday prior to that week. Early Bird Registration – Register by August 15th and save \$40 per week! Early Bird Pricing - \$209 per week. Regular pricing - \$249 per week. Tuition is not prorated for absences. Siblings receive 20% discount! All participants are required to be a member (\$30 annual membership fee). Late pick must register weekly online or by calling 809-1386. We do not offer credits for missed days.
